We live on an island off the coast of Maine in the summer and the use, cleanup and disposal of this awful stuff is a major headache. The boats that did not have anti fouling paint on them always needed to be hauled out of the water once if not twice per season (April-September). In addition it seemed we never allowed enough time to apply and allow the paint to dry properly what with time and tides and had to do some cleanup on the boats with anti fouling paint on them..

In 2007 I was introduced to Nanotech products at of all places the Boston Food Show. The idea that there was a nontoxic, water based product that would eliminate or cut down on the sea growth on the boat bottoms without having to use Antifouling paint was very exciting. We gave it a try. Application and cleanup was a breeze! We did not take any of our boats out during the season to clean and when we finally took them out at closing there was only about 1 inch of growth and it was spotty (the spottiness probably due to inexperience in application). We are looking forward to using it again and with a little more careful application maybe there will be no growth this year!
